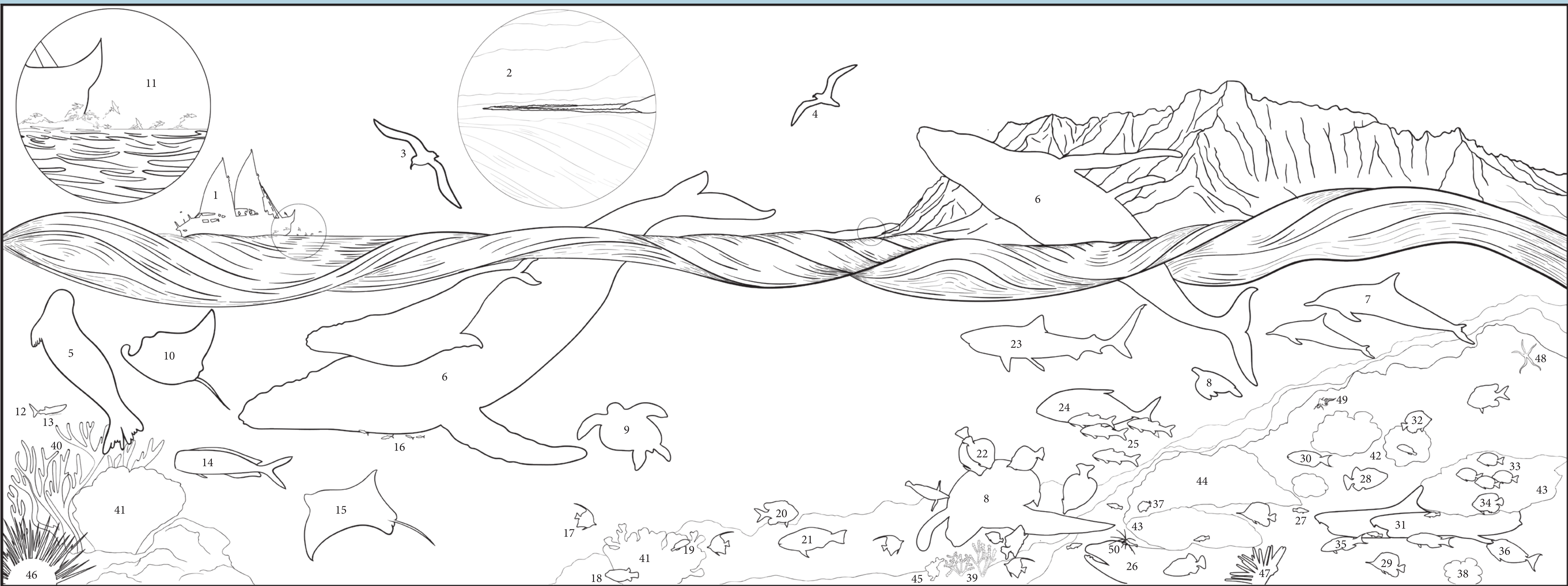


# TRANSIENT TALES: THE STORY OF SYMBIOSIS

Transient Tales depicts the stories found beneath Maui's waters. Beneath the ocean's surface, there are both locals and travellers, some migrating through the seasons and coming to Hawaii to nurse new life. This mural guides you on a journey to notice natural connections that often go unnoticed. Symbiosis is how life interacts with each other, whether it is mutualistic, commensalism, parasitism, or competition. These natural connections show diversity, fragility, and significance of working with one another in order to survive. In this piece, 2 species of birds, 2 species of reptiles, 3 species of mammals, 28 species of fish, 11 species of invertebrates, and 2 species of algae can be found. Notice below the interactions between each species. This mural depicts a few, but there are many different relationships in nature that contribute to healthy ecosystems. Beauty is found everywhere, if one just looks closely.
